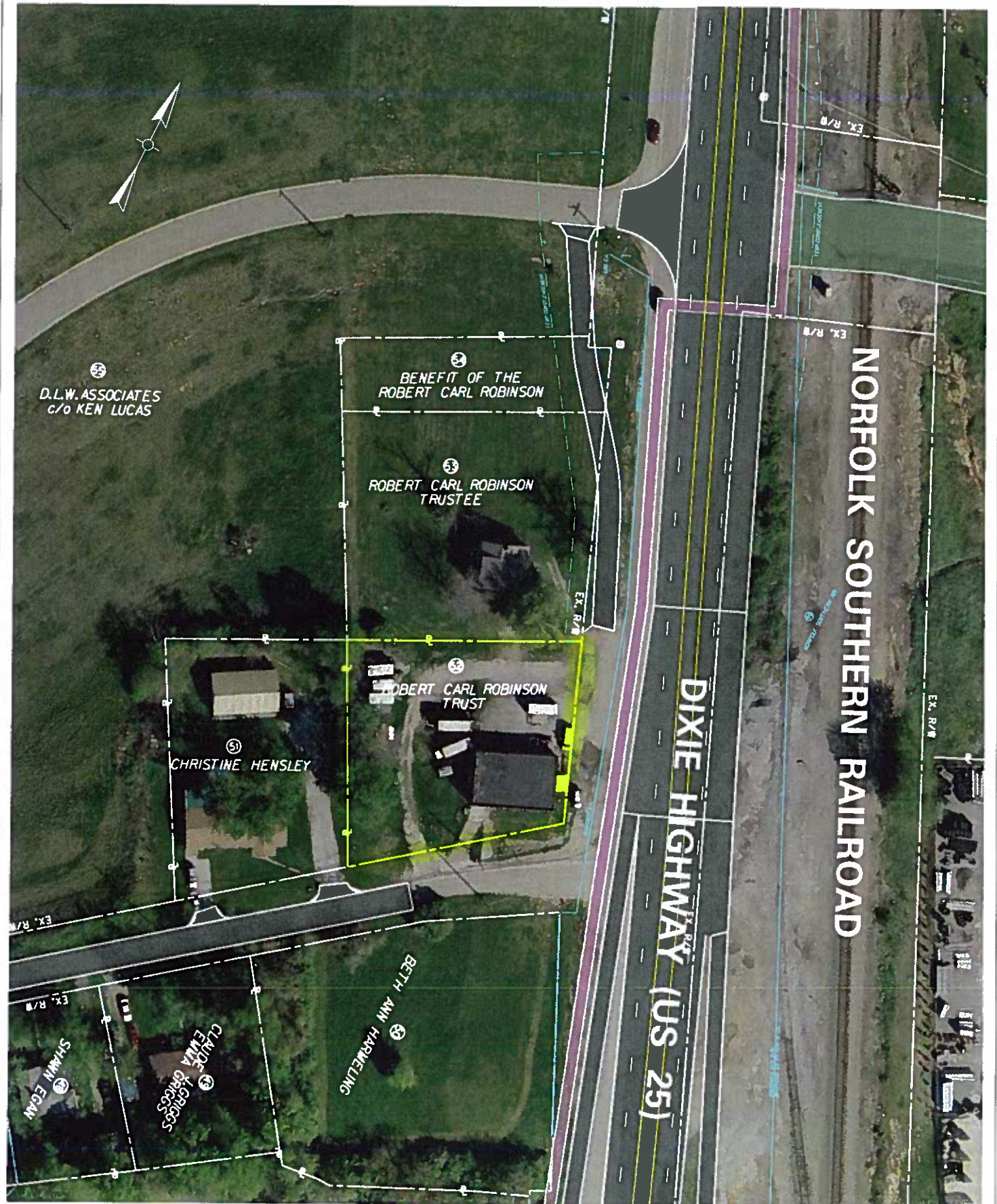




Figure 11. Site 9, Richwood store



Figure 12. Site 9, Side elevation of Richwood store

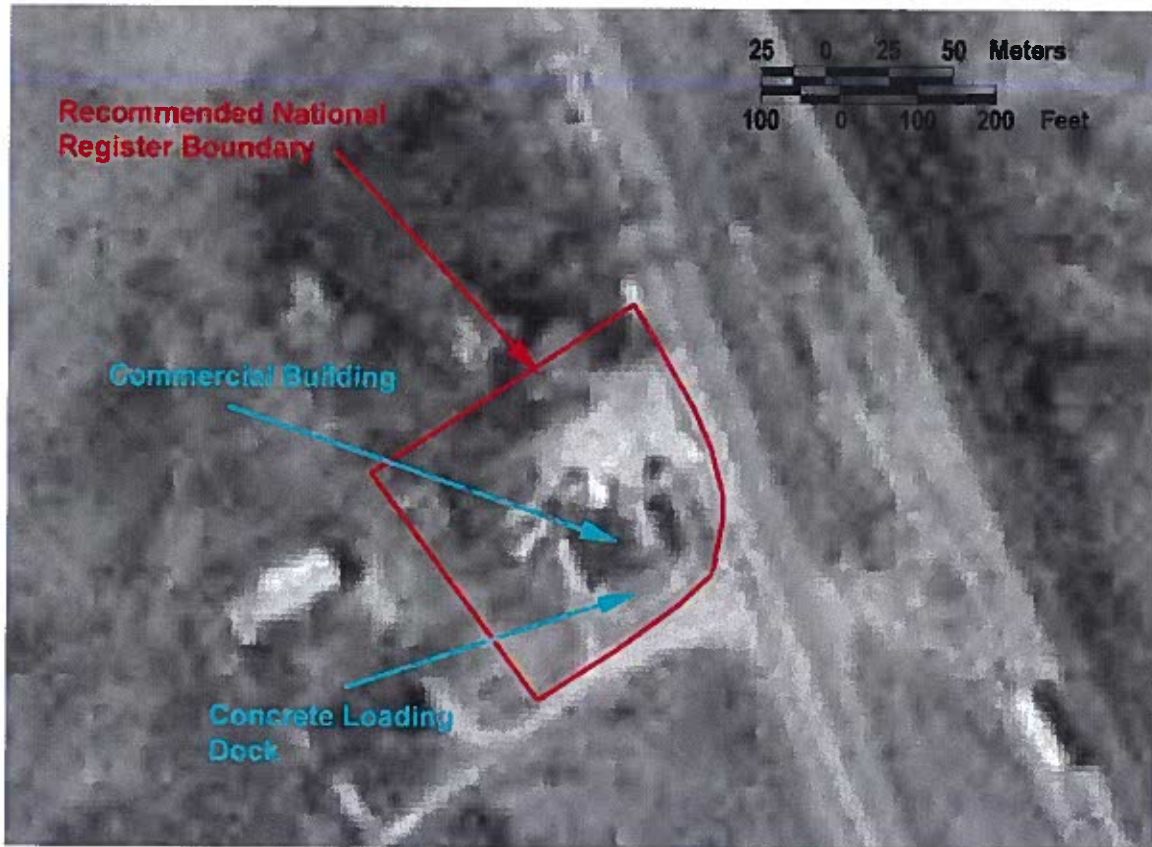


Figure 15. Site 9, Proposed National Register boundary

The State Historic Preservation Office has received for review and approval the above referenced cultural historic survey completed by C. Finney and J. Kirkwood of Cultural Resource Analysts, Inc. We concur that Site 1 (BE-550), Site 2 (BE-551), Site 3 (BE-1331), Site 4 (BE-552; demolished), Site 5 (BE-1332), Site 6 (BE-651; demolished), Site 7 (BE-650; demolished), Site 8 (BE-652), Site 11 (BE-202; demolished), Site 12 (BE-585), Site 13 (BE-584), Site 14 (BE-1334), Site 15 (BE-201; demolished), Site 16 (BE-1335), Site 17 (BE-1336), Site 19 (BE-583), Site 20 (BE-1337), Site 21 (BE-582), Site 23 (BE-580), Site 24 (BE-583), Site 25 (BE-1338), Site 26 (BE-1339), Site 27 (BE-199; demolished), Site 28 (BE-649; demolished), Site 31 (BE-645; demolished), Site 32 (BE-647), Site 33 (BE-1340), Site 34 (BE-642; demolished), Site 35 (BE-644), Site 36 (BE-641), Site 37 (BE-643), Site 38 (BE-640), Site 39 (BE-639), Site 40 (BE-637), Site 41 (BE-1341), Site 42 (BE-636), Site 43 (BE-638; demolished), and Site 44 (BE-635) are not eligible for listing on the National Register individually or within the context of a historic district. We also concur that Site 9 (BE-1333), Site 18 (BE-200), Site 22 (BE-581), and Site 29 (BE-198) are eligible for listing and agree with the determination that No Effect to these properties will result from the construction of any proposed alignment.


We are in disagreement, however, with the determination that Site 10 (BE-586) and Site 30 (BE-648) lack eligibility potential. Both appear to be good, intact examples of the Craftsman Bungalow house form and potentially eligible under Criteria C. However, based upon review of the project mapping it does not appear that Site 10 or Site 30 will experience any effect from the proposed alignments and further discussion regarding eligibility and



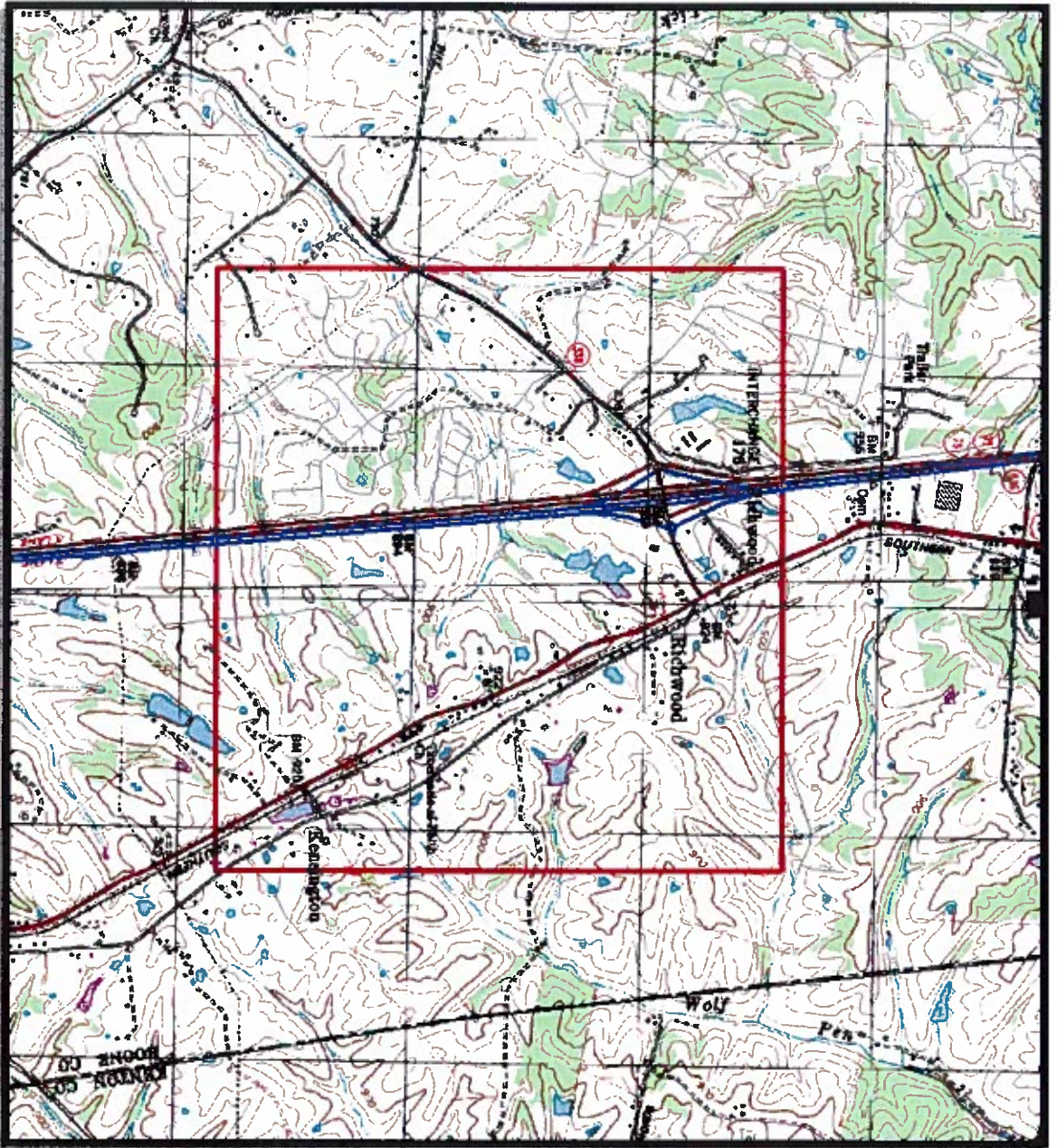
effect will therefore not be required.

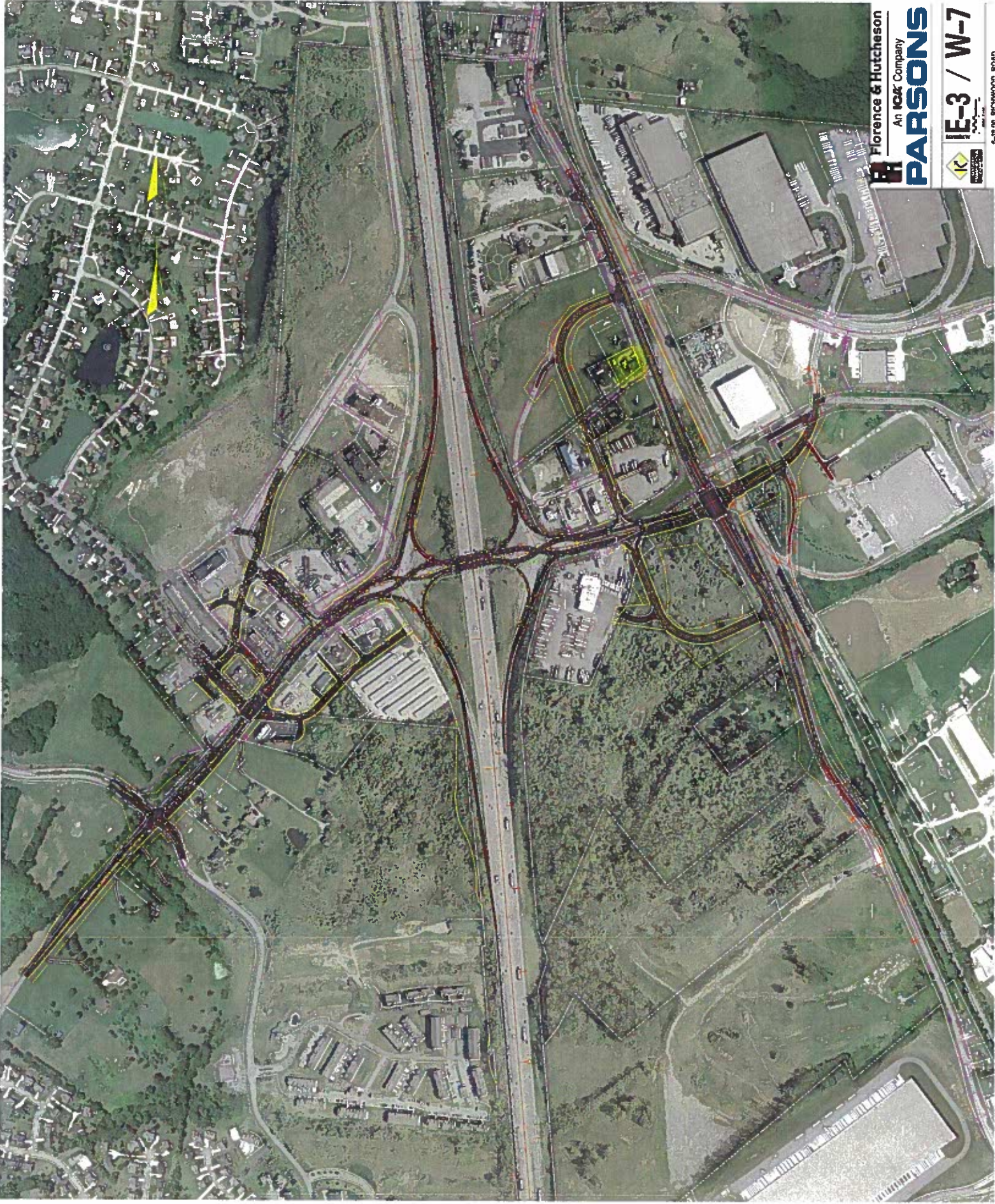
